Dear Families,

I wanted to update you on a COVID-related situation at MMS. We had an exposure within the building this past week and all close contacts have been notified and directed to quarantine. If you did not receive a direct communication from our school nurse (Jayne Champagne), Mr. Clark, or from me, then your MMS student has not been deemed a close contact.

We plan to be open for school as usual tomorrow and moving forward; with ONE exception (unfortunately, the same exception as before). One of our 6th grade teams (Atlantic) will need to be fully remote for Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday of this week. There is no school on Friday due to a Teacher Workshop. We will resume in-person learning with Team Atlantic and the rest of the school following February break. Based on the information we have, we believe this case to be unrelated to the previous case – even though it impacts the same team.

Students on Team Atlantic (only) will follow their usual schedule remotely for these days. The schedule is listed below. Teachers will provide breaks between classes:
